LEARNING

Research tells us you need to learn things 3 times for it to sink in

try learning in 3 different ways

REVISING

Reinforcing what you know and driving these facts and thoughts into your long-term memory


PRACTICING

Use what you have learned to try past paper questions

EFFECTIVE NOTE TAKING

Reading textbooks or notes does not work by itself, encourage taking own notes.

Cornell note taking method includes writing key points or questions in the recall column and a summary of the main points at the bottom




TRY USING MIND MAPS

- A complex idea can be conveyed with just a single image, making it possible to absorb large amounts of data quickly
- Useful for testing knowledge



CREATE FLASHCARDS

- Think about content questions & answers, one word prompts & details
- 1 question per card concise and clear
- Colour code for units/topics
- Read aloud answers
- Sort into strong/weak piles, start again

SOME PRACTICAL TIPS

Have a set study area

Helps get into the revising mindset to study in the same place, have resources around them and limit distractions - phone in another room and no music

Organised notes

Having separate folders or notepads in different colours for each subject helps organisation



Study plan

Plan what units need to be covered for each subject. Set daily/weekly targets. Study in blocks of 45 minutes with short breaks for water/fresh air



The diagram below shows the ultrastructure of a bacterial cell.





The nucleus is a membrane bound organelle which contains the cell's genetic information (DNA); it controls all activities within the cell. Every cell performs many chemical reactions in order to function, these chemical reactions occur in the cytoplasm. The cell membrane is selectively permeable, it allows small and soluble molecules to enter and exit the cell. Ribosomes are the site of protein synthesis, they may be found free in the cytoplasm or attached to a network of membranes within the cell. Mitochondria (singular mitochondrion) are the site of ATP production by aerobic respiration.






Which of the following are you USING to revise?




Do you attend after-school/lunchtime study classes?




Do you know the days/dates of your final SQA exams? 129 responses




